Verdict for our client:

A jury returned a verdict in favor of our client after a three day trial in New Haven Superior Court. In this wrongful termination case, our lawyers argued that our client, the plaintiff, was terminated because he attempted to exercise his rights under the Workers Compensation Act, after he slipped in the defendant employer's parking lot. Shortly after his injury, our client requested accident forms to document the incident. Not only did the defendant/employer deny our client the forms, but shortly thereafter he was terminated. Although the defendant claimed the termination was for unrelated reasons, the jury found in favor of our client and awarded damages in excess of \$100k.
